REQUIREMENTS and IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Although this program is designed specifically for RHNs, it is open to all health care professionals with a background in Natural Nutrition. Non-graduates of CSNN must provide copies of transcripts in order to qualify and write an entry exam.

The Advanced Holistic Nutrition Program consists of both mandatory and elective subjects, allowing students to design and complete their own course of study at their own pace. Students have four years from the time they finish their first workshop to complete the required number of credits. All mandatory courses must be completed.

A number of credits are attached to each subject, depending on its length. An average of 80% must be obtained for each subject. To qualify for the Advanced Holistic Nutrition Diploma, RHNs need to accumulate 50 credits. Other practitioners require 57 credits. **These workshops also qualify as IONC and CANNP upgrade hours. Please contact the branch for details.**
